R E S O L U T I O N

These nations gathered here together solemnly undertake to support global and regional measures towards a Nuclear Weapons Convention. (NWC) .We support policies that will:

- Prohibit the development, testing, production, stockpiling, transfer, use and threat of nuclear weapons.
- Establish an international agency charged with ensuring that countries comply with the terms of the treaty: including regular reporting, inspections of weapons facilities, satellite intelligence and close monitoring of nuclear materials.

We therefore strongly assert that:

- Nuclear armed nations refrain from acquiring new nuclear weapons or modernizing existing ones.
- Non-nuclear-armed nations adopt defence postures that do not rely on the nuclear weapons of other nations.

Stages towards elimination (Suggested timetable – 15 years)

| 1. Take all nuclear weapons off <i>hair trigger alert</i> | <u>Immediately!</u> |
| 2. Remove nuclear weapons from deployment | 2010-15 |
| 3. Remove the warheads from their delivery vehicles | 2015-2018 |
| 4. Disable the warheads by removing the explosive “ pits ” | 2018-2020 |
| 5. Place the fissile material under United Nations control. | 2020-2023 |
